



Thank you for your interest in our Foundations for Social Transformation course. This course is registered with the University of the Nations (DEV/HMT 365/366) and the successful completion of a DTS is a prerequisite for applying for this course.

This course has a duration of six months (24 weeks): three-month lecture phase and three-month outreach phase where the student will have the opportunity to apply the knowledge they have acquired in a community setting.

By presenting a Biblical worldview, the target of the FST is to bring understanding that man is an ambassador of social change. This course motivates the student to develop his/her role in the seven areas of influence in society, seeking growth in the foundations of physical, spiritual, social and intellectual needs. Developing projects with correct fundamentals that lead to understanding the basic needs and God's intentions for man is the focus of the FST course.
